

Can you use Cash App to transfer to Apple Pay? “Cash App Apple Pay”

Cash App cannot send funds directly to Apple Pay 1-(855)(470)(3280). You need to first move your money to a linked bank account 1-(855)(470)(3280). Apple Pay can then add funds from that bank account 1-(855)(470)(3280). Transfer your Cash App balance to your bank 1-(855)(470)(3280) by selecting Cash Out in the app.

No, you **cannot directly transfer money from Cash App 1-(855)(470)(3280) to Apple Pay**, because Cash App and Apple Pay operate as separate payment systems.
