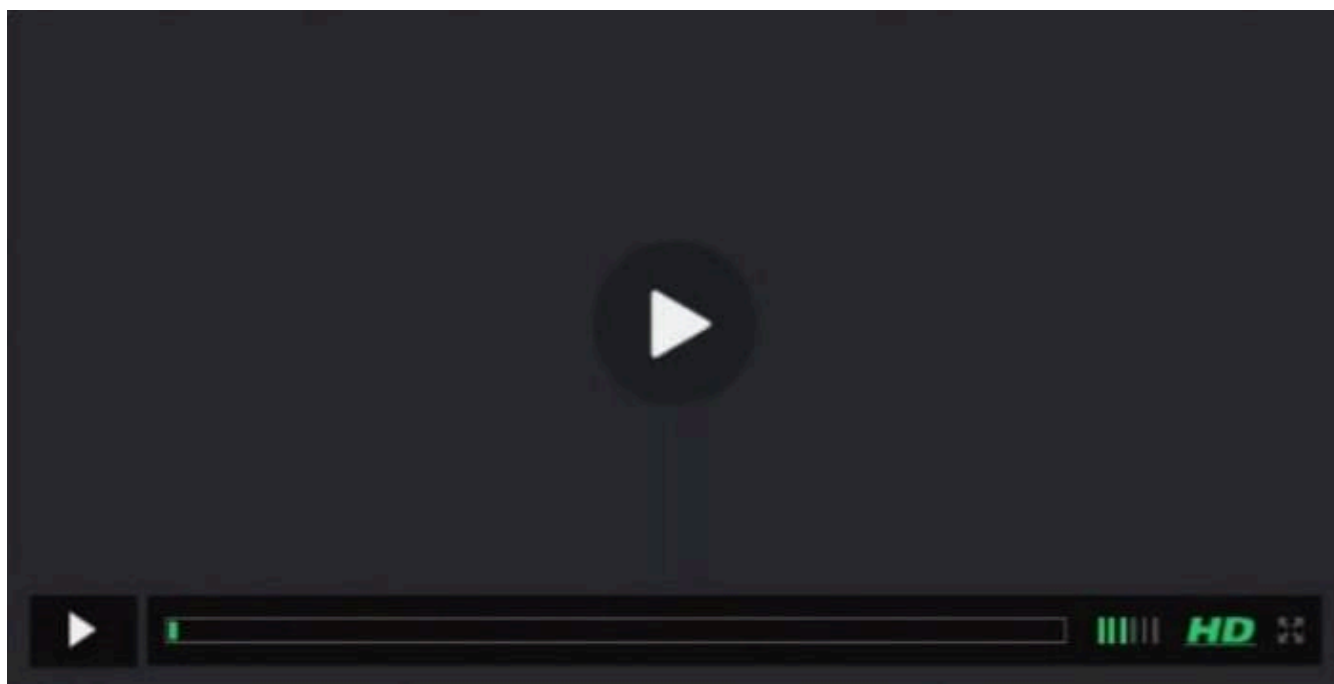

Match Context & Importance

Nigeria (Super Eagles)

Nigeria entered this fixture **already qualified for the Round of 16**, having won their first two group matches convincingly. Their focus in this game is to:

- Secure **top spot in Group C**
- Maintain momentum heading into the knockout rounds
- Possibly rotate the squad to rest key players

Nigeria are three-time AFCON champions and one of the tournament favourites.

Uganda (The Cranes)

- **Attack:** Ademola Lookman, Victor Osimhen (or rotated striker), Chidera Ejuke

Nigeria may rotate players depending on fitness and discipline concerns.

Uganda (Expected XI – 4-4-1-1)

- **Defenders:** Kenneth Semakula, Toby Sibbick, Jordan Obita, Aziz Kayondo
- **Midfield:** Allan Okello, Bobosi Byaruhanga, Denis Omedi, Rogers Mato
 - **Support Forward:** Travis Mutyaba
 - **Striker:** Uche Ikpeazu

Uganda are expected to field their **strongest possible team**.

Tactical Breakdown

Nigeria's Approach

- Controlled possession
- Strong midfield screening
- Quick transitions from wide areas
- Aerial threat in the box

Nigeria's depth allows them to stay competitive even with squad rotation.

Uganda's Strategy

- Compact defensive shape
- Aggressive pressing in midfield
- Quick counters and long balls
- Heavy reliance on set pieces

Uganda's discipline and energy will be crucial.
